CLUBS:

Alexandre's

An intimate club in the heart of Oaklawn with a friendly, neighborhood atmosphere. Popular on weekends.

Antro Discoteque

A trendy, dance club just off the Cedar Springs strip. Popular African-American dance crowd club.

Bill's Hideaway

Long time popular haunt for piano-bar fans with live entertainment most every night of the week. Also know for it's great Sunday afternoon cookouts on the patio.

Buddies II

This women's bar is open, friendly and welcoming to men as well. Popular karaoke club and great dance floor and regular pool tournaments. Summertime this club offers a great patio and swimming pool. Cover on weekends.

Crew's Inn

Great neighborhood club just 5 minutes from Oaklawn's Cedar Springs with lots of weeknight drink specials, pool tournaments and dancing.

Dallas Eagle

This is Dallas' very popular leather/levis club located just 8 minutes from Cedar Springs. The bar has Internet parties, weekly pool tournaments and plays host to many local regional and national leather events such as the Bear Round-Up and Mr. Southwest Leather.

Cross Bar

A fun, neighborhood club just up Lemmon Avenue from the Cedar Springs strip with a friendly, party atmosphere. A great patio with cookouts and karaoke several nights a week.

Havana

A trendy, retro-style crowd populates this nightspot right in the heart of Oaklawn. Also serving dinner specials with a Cuban-Latin flavor.

Hidden Door

One of the oldest and still very popular neighborhood clubs in Dallas. Boasts a friendly, diverse crowd and an extremely popular patio.

J.R's Bar & Grill

The hot spot on Cedar Springs for the young, fun Abercrombie crowd. One of Dallas' newest, hi-tech clubs on the Cedar Springs strip. Beautifully appointed with attached patio, dance floor and featuring live entertainment and female impersonation shows.

Pub Pegasus

A great neighborhood hangout with a friendly regular crowd and good music.

The Rose Room

Located in the beautiful newly remodeled Station 4 nightclub, the Rose Room is a first-class, entertainment showroom with the very finest in the art of female impersonation. Shows by a regular cast of highly talented performers and many nationally known female impersonators in an upscale cabaret nightclub setting. Cover charge.

Round-Up Saloon

In the very center of the Cedar Springs strip.

Throckmorton Mining Company

This is a very popular club with hot music, featuring a more intimate atmosphere with low lighting, ice cold drinks, and a crowd of "very" friendly regulars who know how to have fun. Two levels of this club add to the visual entertainment.

Tin Room

Another friendly, neighborhood club with a warm, cozy atmosphere. Good regular crowd, pool table, and welcoming staff.

Woody's Sports and Video Bar
